## Haven Ground Regulations

1. All persons entering this ground are only admitted subject to these rules and regulations of the Football Association

2. The Club reserves the right to prosecute or to eject, or cause to be ejected, any persons who within the ground or the club premises is considered by the club, it's employees or agents (hereafter called the Club), in their absolute discretion to be, or to have been, behaving in any of the following ways:-

a) Entering the field of play before or during the course of a game of a game. The field of play is that area within the railings surrounding the perimeter of the pitch.

b) Using obscene or abusive language or persistent swearing.

c) Being drunk or under the influence of drink or drugs to any degree.

d) Making vulgar gestures.

e) Using terms of abuse, racial or otherwise.

3) No bottles, metal cans, glasses, placards, banners, firearms, knives or other similar articles are permitted and the Police and Club stewards have the right to search any spectator at anytime, and to confiscate any article which they consider could be a danger to other spectators.

4. NO alcohol to be consumed within the ground. Alcohol can only be consumed within the confines of the Clubhouse. Passes are available at half-time.

5. The climbing of floodlight pylons, stands and other building structures is strictly forbidden. Club Stewards have the right to eject any persons found doing so.

6. ALL vehicles parked in and around the ground are parked at the owner's own risk

7. No unauthorised vehicles can be parked within the Clubhouse car park and the Club reserves the right to move any vehicles in contravention of this regulation and shall not liable for any damages caused.

# Our Visitors Today

## Horsham YMCA

Horsham YMCA Football Club was formed in 1898. During the first 31 years of the club's existence they played at Lyons Field, the name of which is derived from the Bowes-Lyons family who owned a substantial amount of land around Horsham at one time.

In 1929 the club moved to its present ground at Gorings Mead for which they were able to secure the freehold at a later date. In the early years 'YM' played in the Horsham District League before moving to the Crawley League and subsequently to the Mid Sussex League. Their rise through the later two leagues was swift and facilitated the club's entry into the Sussex County League in 1959.

In that first season, YM finished twelfth out of fifteen teams and then began a gradual improvement. They spent seven years in Division 2 before gaining promotion in 1966 as Champions. The club gained Division 1 status and remained there for sixteen seasons until the end of the 1981/82 season, when unfortunately they were relegated. Despite relegation, the club bounced straight back as Division 2 champions in the following season. They spent five seasons in the top division before being relegated at the end of the 1987/88 season. Promotion back to Division 1 for the third time was achieved by finishing third in 1994/95. During the following 6 seasons YM consolidated their Division 1 status.

In the 1999/00 season, YM had their best ever results in both the FA Cup going out to Chelmsford City in the 4th Qualifying round in front of 960 supporters and in the FA Vase going out in the 4th Rd to AFC Totton. During that season the club also reached the semi-finals of the Sussex Senior Cup which they also achieved in the following season. However they did win the Sussex RUR Cup in that following season beating Burgess Hill Town 3-0 in the Final. In 2001/02 YM won the John O'Hara League Cup beating Ringmer 2-0.

The 2002/03 season YM cruised high in the league all season, recording a record 22-1 victory over Littlehampton Town, before finally being pipped into third position at the end of the season.

In 2004/05 The Div One title was won for the first time 15 points clear of Rye United. However disappointment followed when promotion to the Isthmian League was denied because of ground grading issues. In 2005/06 YM again won the Div 1 title and this time the facilities were deemed fit to allow the club to join the Isthmian Division One South for the 2006/07 season. After competing for two seasons in Division One South, the club were relegated back to the Sussex County League. However they bounced straight back the following season.

The 2009/10 YM achieved 11th place and their highest ever points total in the Ryman League. But were relegated the following season back to the Sussex County League.

In 2012/13 YM achieved a mid table finish and finished in 4th place in 2013/14. Nonetheless

2013/14 was an impressive season, with YM reaching the semi-finals of the Sussex Senior Cup and winning the RUR Cup on penalties in their final game of the season.

In 2014/15 YM had another good season finishing in 5th place by the seasons end and in the following season 2015/16 they again did well finishing this time 7th in the newly formed Sussex Combination League Premier Division.

The 2016/17 season saw YM finish in 10th Position just above Crawley Down Gatwick in 11th place and in 2017/18 they finished in 4th place after a good 2nd half of the season. So far in the current season Horsham YMCA are lying in 3rd position after an impressive start to the season.

In 2018/19: YM had a very good season finishing in 2nd position 9 points behind the champions Chichester City. With Eastbourne Town and Newhaven just 2 points adrift.

In 2019/20: The Covid-19 season. YM were not at their usual best and were in 12th position when the Season was eventually abandoned.

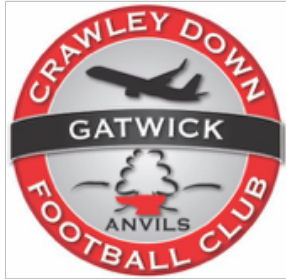

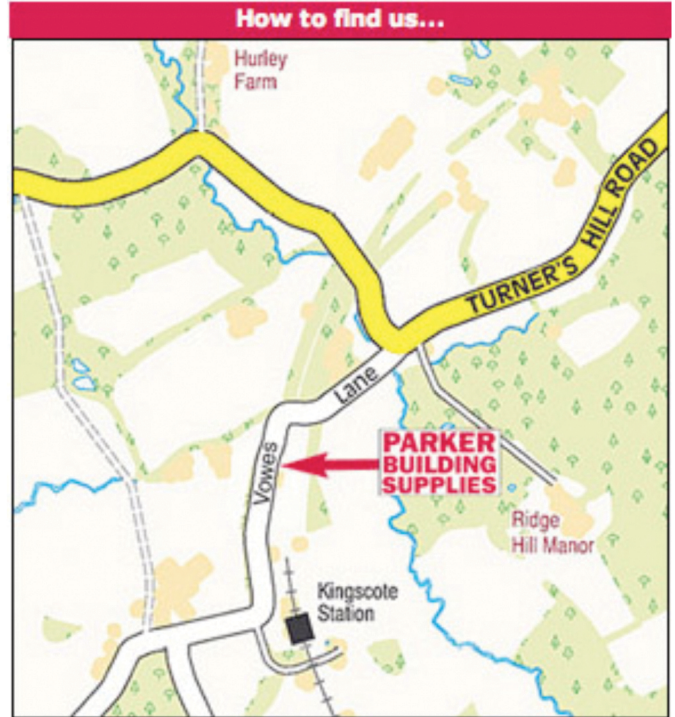

Welcome to The Haven for our first home competitive fixture of the season as we entertain Horsham YMCA in the SCFL Premier Division.

It has been a really extraordinary and life changing time for everyone since my last programme notes. Lockdown in March caused last season to be abandoned and the Covid-19 restrictions in place have made this a very strange start to the current campaign.

Preseason went well with only one loss to a very good, Southampton based, AFC Stoneham side from the Wessex League. The season itself has kicked off with two very impressive victories in the two games played. We recorded a brilliant away win at Crowborough last Tuesday in the FA Cup. The game was a thriller but, in my view, we thoroughly deserved the 4-3 victory. We now take on Egham Town from the Combined Counties League on Saturday 12 September at Egham. We travelled to Peacehaven in the opening league game last Saturday and a very impressive performance saw us come away with a 3-1 win.

Most of last season's squad are back for another campaign and we have added in some exciting new signings too. The new faces, Harvey Blake, Dave Brown, Guy Harding, Lewis Scally, Phil Johnson and Ashley Dugdale have fitted in well.

Phil Johnson has certainly hit the ground running with two goals in two substitute appearances so far. Long may it continue. It is good to see Ollie Broad back and seeming to enjoy his football. It is also fantastic to see Mike Spence fit and healthy and back to his mercurial perpetual motion best in midfield.

At the last preseason training session, we had a very belated mini presentation event for last season. For the record the awards went to Marc Pelling players' player and supporters' player, Oli Leslie was leading goal scorer and Michael Wood was Manager's player. All thoroughly well deserved.

Having held our admission price unchanged in my six seasons as Chairman we have had to bow to economic pressures and increase matchday admission to £6.00 with Blue badge holder £4.00. Accompanied children under 16 will still be free. That still makes us one of the best value venues in the league both in terms of price and entertainment value. With ever increasing costs we are sure that our loyal fans will realise that we had no alternative but to implement this change in the interests of the Club. We will be accepting contactless payment which will be the preferred method of payment. Alternatively, we will require the correct money to be tendered. No change will be given on the day.

We have made the decision that for this season our programme will be digital only. The programme will be free to download on match days. Due to Covid-19 restrictions there will be no half time or post match hospitality for players or visiting committee members. Initially we will not be opening the refreshment van but we will review that after the first few games once we have settled into the new reality.

Please help us to keep everyone safe by observing the social distancing protocols in the ground and don't forget to wash hands and use the sanitisers at the entrance to the toilets.

I hope we can keep up the momentum tonight although it is never easy against YM!

# ANVILS 'The History'



**Crawley Down Gatwick FC** have made a remarkable rise from parks football to the Ryman League in less than 20 years. The club was only formed in 1993 but have enjoyed the type of success many could only hope for in their short history. In 2011 Sussex County League title success and promotion to Step 4 Football was followed by an appearance at the AMEX in the Sussex Senior Cup Final in 2012.

**1983-95** Delving back into the history books to 1983, Crawley Down United could be found nestled in Division Six of the Mid Sussex League. By 1988 the club had risen to Div One, winning three league titles and finishing runners-up on two occasions. After three seasons in Div One they won promotion to the Premier Division as runners up to Lindfield. **1993/94** culminated in a merger of four local sides and adopting the name Crawley Down Village they finished third in the following season. 1994/5 they claimed their first Premier Division title by a massive margin of ten points from 2nd placed Wealden.

**1995-2003** In 1995 the Anvils joined the Sussex County League Division Three. In the first season they finished second and found themselves making an even swifter move into Senior Football. They also reached the final of the Intermediate Cup. The first two seasons in Division Two provided much sought after consolidation but in the 1998-99 season they finished in a promotion position but only to be denied a place in Division One because they could not persuade Mid Sussex District Council to allow the installation of floodlights in time. The following season they thought they had finished in a promotion spot again only to be thwarted by a late decision to award Lancing three extra points after Mile Oak had fielded an illegible player. The next four seasons were not so easy for the club with changes of management and they finished no higher than 11th in that period.

**The 2004-07** era was better as they finished tenth and fifth and In the Division Two Cup, they reached the semi-final stage two years running. 2006-07 was a struggle only staying up after an outstanding finish to the season loosing just two of the last 14 matches. Cup form was better, reaching both the Q/F of the Sussex RUR Cup and the Div Two Cup.

**2007-08** was a massive year for the club as the culmination of 10 years' hard work behind the scenes paid off with the Anvils given the go ahead to upgrade facilities. Floodlights, hard standing and stands followed and were in place for the start of the new season. The Team finished 6th and reached the semi-final of the John O'Hara League Cup. In the FA Vase they reached the 4th round losing away at Brockenhurst. The Anvils also entertained Brighton & HA in the Sussex Senior Cup. By now, the club were gaining momentum on and off the pitch and they finally won promotion to Div One with a third place finish.

**2009-2010** Many expected the Division One new boys to struggle but they defied the odds to enjoy a tremendous season, finishing eighth in the league and enjoying good cup runs in the FA Cup and FA Vase as well as reaching the League Cup Final.

**2010-11** Proved to be the most successful season in the club's history as the Anvils won the County League Division One and promotion to the Ryman League by a margin of 15 points as well as winning the RUR Cup. They reached the semi-finals of both the John O'Hara and the Sussex Senior Cups where they lost to Blue Square prem side Eastbourne Borough. **2011-14** Saw the Club compete in the Ryman Isthmian South for the first time and the Club set about building a team to compete at this level, finishing in 15th place and also getting to the Sussex Senior Cup Final at the AMEX, losing out in the last minute to Ryman South Champions Whitehawk. A name change to Crawley Down Gatwick FC was approved highlighting the wider area to which the Club is now associated. **2012/13** Season started remarkably well with the team topping the Ryman South table through to November but finally finishing in 13th position. Forced Manager changes meant a massive dip in form in **2013/14**, which saw the Anvils plummet from the top of the table to 19th Place by the end of Jan and finally end up second to bottom and relegation back to the Sussex County League. **2014/15** The Club decided after rejoining the County League to go back to its roots and use local players, unfortunately this did not work out and the Club were in the relegation zone by Xmas. The team finally ended 2nd to bottom and further relegation followed to the newly named Southern Combination League Div 1. **2015/17** Saw the revival of the side under Paul Cooper as the rebuilt Anvils challenged at the top all season, finally finishing in 2nd place behind Haywards Hth Town and 14 points clear of 3rd placed Oakwood to gain promotion back to the Southern Combination Premier Division.

**2017-19** Back in the SCL Prem the side continued its improvement finishing in a midtable position and reached the RUR Cup Final in that first year. The following season they achieved a midtable finish again and a PB cup Semi final. James Day took over the side from **2018-19** and did well in his first season as the side finished in 9<sup>th</sup> place with 57 points. **2019/20** Covid dominated and the League was abandoned with CDG in 6th Pos.

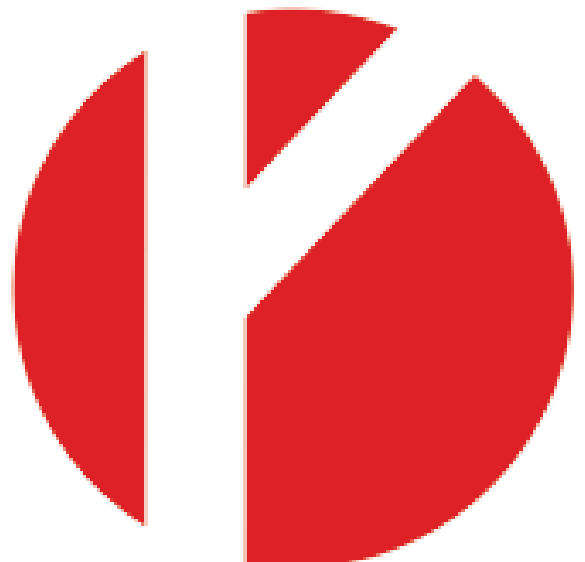
